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Delay in submission of 7th CPC report

The 7th CPC concluded its deliberations and finalised its report. But due to pressure put by the Government of India report is not likely to be out till the Bihar election is over upto 8-11-2015.

Even if the report is submitted the Government might plead for some more time to study the report and arrive at conclusion.

Therefore National Joint Council of Action decided to defer the Indefinite Strike decision of 23rd November, 2015; and it will be during Budget Session of Parliament i.e. from February to April 2016. The exact date of commencement of the Strike will be decided by National JCA when the 7th CPC report is available.

We think that this is the right decision of NJCA. In this context the PJCA also should review the decision of Indefinite Strike action commencing from 23rd November, 2015; and we must fall in line with NJCA.

चेअरमैन द्वारा 7वे वेतन आयोग की रिपोर्ट पूरी तरह तैयार है। किंतु सरकार द्वारा उसे सरकार को सुपूर्द करने पर रोक लगा कर रिपोर्ट को बिहार राज्य के चुनाव होने के बाद पेश करने को कहा गया है, ऐसा सूत्रों का मानना है।

NJCA द्वारा इस परिस्थिति की समीक्षा की गयी तथा निर्णय लिया कि 23 नवंबर 2015 की प्रस्तावित अनिश्चितकालीन हड़ताल को स्थगित कर इस हड़ताल को लोकसभा के बजट सेशन के समय किया जाये अर्थात् फरवरी से अप्रैल 2016 के बीच किसी नियत तारीख से सभी केंद्रीय कर्मचारी अनिश्चितकालीन हड़ताल पर रहेंगे, तारीख का निर्णय उस समय लिया जायेगा।

हमें इस स्थिति को मनेजर रखकर पोस्टल JCA द्वारा प्रस्तावित अनिश्चित हड़ताल स्थगित कर NJCA के साथ मिलकर ही हड़ताल पर जाना होगा ताकि हड़ताल फलदाय हो सके।

7वे वेतन आयोग में GDS को सम्मिलित नहीं किया गया है। और GDS कर्मचारियों के लिए एक सदस्यीय कमेटी का गठन होना है। इस कमेटी पर चेयरमैन निवृत्त न्यायमूर्ति की नियुक्ति आवश्यक है। सरकार इस पद के लिए निवृत्त पोस्टल बोर्ड के मेंबर को नियुक्त करने की कोशिश में है। हमें GDS कर्मचारियों के साथ कंधे से कंधा मिलाकर एक सदस्यीय कमेटी के चेयरमैन पद पर निवृत्त न्यायमूर्ति की नियुक्ति के लिए खड़ा होना आवश्यक ही नहीं अपितु यह हमारी जिम्मेदारी है।

Dear Comrade,

The National JCA met today on 30-09-2015. In the background of the engineered delay in the submission of the 7th CPC report, the meeting reviewed the decision to go for indefinite strike action commencing from 23rd Nov. 2015 and arrived the following conclusions.

1. The 7th CPC, as per the indication the NJCA had, concluded its deliberations and finalised its report. But due to the pressure exerted by the GOI the report is not likely to be out till the Bihar election is going to be concluded on 8-11-2015.
2. Even if the report is given, the Government might plead for some more time to consider the same and arrive at conclusions.
3. Even though the charter of demand contain other major issues, viz FDI, outsourcing, New Pension Scheme etc, the CPC related issues especially the revision of wages has its own significance and struggle without the said issue is impracticable.
4. The meeting also noted that after the impressive march to parliament held on 28th April, 2015, no serious programme of action was undertaken, which has created a certain complacency in the movement. The meeting noted the necessity to rejuvenate the NJCA functioning at all levels.



5. It was also noted that there are states which have not held the state level conventions and consequently have not brought into being the state apparatus required to spearhead a serious action like indefinite strike.
 6. In view of above mentioned conclusions, the National JCA has decided to defer the strike action slated for 23rd November, 2015 to a date during the Budget session of the Parliament i.e. from February to April 2016. The exact date of commencement of the strike will be decided by the National JCA when the 7th CPC report is available.
 7. The NJCA also has decided to call upon all Federations of Central Government Employees to organise a massive protest demonstration in front of all work-spots/offices on **19th November, 2015** wearies Black Badge to register our anger and resentment over the Government's action in engineering delay in the submission of the report by the 7th CPC.
 8. The National JCA leaders and all standing council members will sit on a **day long Dharna at Jantar Mantar on 19-11-2015** by wearies Black Badge to highlight the anti-worker attitude of the GOI and its concerted efforts to undermine the functionign of JCM.

We also send herewith the resolution adopted at the meeting which has been forwarded to the Government already.

RESOLUTION

1. The National JCA of Central Government Employee, which met today on 30-09-2015 at New Delhi strongly condemns the Governments' action in engineering delay in the submission of 7th CPC report. The 7th CPC was to submit its report on 28th August 2015. i.e. on the expiry of 18th months time provided to it by the Government as per the terms of reference. The demand for interim-relief and merger of DA was denied. The Government refused to amend the terms of reference despite repeated appeals made by the National JCA on several occasions.
2. The Charter of demand submitted by the National JCA to the cabinet Secretary realisation of which it has been decided to organize indefinite strike commencing from 23rd November, 2015 has remained unattended and unsettled. No follow up action was initiated by the Government after discussion of the issues at the level of Secretary personnel held on 25th February 2015.
3. The National Council JCM has not met in the past 5 years even once, giving the impression that the Government's intention is to award a natural death to the negotiating forums and compel the employees to tread the path of struggle for realization of the demands. Many departmental council have been placed on hibernation for the part one decade.
4. The National JCA has come to the inescapable conclusion that the present Govt has no intention to reach out to a settlement on any issue pertaining to the Central Govt. Employees, given its anti labour, anti people attitude.
5. The National JCA has decided to call upon the Central Government Employees throughout the country to organise massive protest demonstration jointly on 19th November, 2015 in front of all Offices/work place eliciting the participation of all employees workers and pass resolution and send the same to the Finnce Minister and the Cabinet Secretary.

Postal JCA Dharna in Jantar Mantar, New Delhi on 22nd September

POSTAL JCA OF NFPE & FNPO STAGE DHARNA IN JANTAR MANTAR

The Postal Joint Council of Action of NFPE & FNPO with their GDS Unions staged a Dharna in Jantar Mantar today stressing their Postal Charter of Demands. However the focus had been on the issue of GDS.

The JCA demanded that the GDS wage issues should be referred to the 7th CPC for appropriate recommendations instead of referring them to any Officer headed Committee. The NFPE Federal Executive decision to discuss with Postal JCA for a decision to go on strike from November 23 for the Postal Charter with GDS issue as the prime demand was declared in the Dharna by the Secretary General NFPE. The **Secretary General FNPO** also was favourable for an action in November and he too stressed the need for united action by JCA as in the past.

The Dharna was presided over by Shri Giriraj Singh the NFPE President. Shri K.Ragavendran Ex-SG NFPE and GS AIPRPA inaugurated the Dharna. Sarveshri R.N.Parashar (SG NFPE); D.Theagarajan (SG FNPO); **Devendra Kumar (AGS R3 FNPO)**; P.Suresh (GS R4); T.Satyanarayana (GS Postal Accounts); Virendra Tewary (GS SBCO); P.Pandurangarao (GS AIPEU GDS(NFPE)); D.B.Mohanty (Dy.GS P4); A.Manoharan (Wkg President NFPE); Raj Kumar (Treasurer NFPE); J.Ramamurthy (CHQ P3 President); Balwinder Singh (Financial Secretary P3 CHQ); K.P.singh (AGS R3 CHQ); A.K.Gowtham (Treasurer R3 CHQ); K.C.Verma (C/S R3 Delhi); Shivlal (C/S P4 Delhi); and many other Office Bearers of various CHQ addressed the meeting.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : - Procedure for booking of air-tickets on LTC - Clarification reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No. 31011/4/2014-Estt. (A-IV) dated 19th June, 2014 which lays down that the Government employees are required to book the air tickets directly from the airlines (Booking counters, website of airlines) or by utilizing the service of Authorized Travel Agents viz. 'M/s Balmer Lawrie & Company', 'M/s. Ashok Travels & Tours' and 'IRCTC' (to the extent IRTCTC is authorized as per DoPT O.M. No. 31011/6/2002-Estt. (A) dated 02-12-2009) while undertaking LTC journey(s). Vide DoPT's O.M. 31011/5/2014-Estt. (A-IV) dated 24-09-2014, the web-portal of these authorized travel agents will also be treated as an acceptable mode for purchase of air tickets on LTC subject to the conditions stated vide Department of Expenditure's O.M. No. 19024/1/2012-E-IV dated 5th September, 2014.

2. It has been observed that various Ministries/Departments continue to send reference to DoPT seeking relaxation regarding the booking of air tickets for the purpose of LTC from the travel agents not authorised by the aforesaid O.M.. In most of the cases, the common reason stated by the LTC beneficiaries is that they were not aware of the guidelines and inadvertently booked the tickets from other travel agents.

3. All the Ministries/Departments are advised to ensure a wide circulation of the guidelines as stated in para 1 of this O.M.. This point may also be emphasized by the Administration whenever any advance is sought or intention to avail LTC is conveyed by the Government servant.

**Subject: CGHS Rates for Cancer Surgery for hospitals empanelled
under CGHS - Revised w.e.f. date of issue of this order.**

The undersigned is directed to draw attention to the Office Memorandum of even no. dated the 1st October, 2014 and to clarify that CGHS rates for Cancer Surgery at Hospitals empanelled under CGHS shall be as per the details given below:

2.1 Rates of Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai (2012), as mentioned below for Cancer surgical procedures are treated as CGHS rates for NABH accredited hospitals For Non-NABH accredited hospitals the rates would be reduced by 15%. These rates are for treatment for Semi private ward entitled class with 10% decrease for Gl. Ward and 15% enhancement for Private ward entitled beneficiaries.

2.2 The duration of treatment for different categories of Surgery will be as follows:

Category-I 1-2 days

Category-II 3-5 days

(7-10 days in respect of operations involving Abdominal/thoracic cavity)

Category III, IV, V & VI 12... 14 days

2.3 The surgical procedures are enlisted under Categories - I, II, III, IV, V & VI and the list is annexed to this Office Order (at Annexure-I).

2.4 Rates applicable for room rent (Accommodation Charges) for different categories of wards are given below:

General ward	-	Rs. 1000/- per day
Semi-private ward	-	Rs. 2000/- per day
Private ward	-	Rs. 3000/- per day

CGHS beneficiaries are entitled to facilities of private, semi-private or general ward depending on their basic pay / pension. The entitlement is as follows:

S. No.	Basic Pay (without the inclusion of grade pay)	Entitlement
1.	Upto Rs. 13,950/-	General Ward
2.	Between Rs. 13,951/- and Rs. 19,530/-	Semi-Private Ward
3.	Rs. 19,540/- and above	Private Ward

For any **day care procedure** requiring short admission - a few hours to one day-accommodation charge for one day as per entitlement shall be applicable provided the patient has been admitted in a room as per his/her entitlement.

2.5 Investigation rates and procedure charges for Chemotherapy shall be as per CGHS prescribed rates of concerned city. In case of Chemotherapy the rates prescribed are procedural charges only. Room rent, investigations and cost of medicines are reimbursable in addition to procedural charges.

2.6 Consultation fee shall be as per CGHS rates applicable.

2.7 Investigations rates shall be as per CGHS prescribed rates of concerned city.

2.8 Cost of Implants / stents / grafts is reimbursable in addition to package rates as per CGHS ceiling rates for Implants / stents / grafts.

2.9 The rates applicable for Anesthesia, Operation, Theatre and Surgery Charges under Grades - I, II, III, IV, V and VI are given below.

2.10 The admissible amount for Cancer surgery shall be calculated as per the formula given below:

‘Room rent as applicable + Anesthesia Charges (as per category) + OT Charges (as pr category) + Surgery Charges (as per category) + Investigations at CGHS rates + Cost of Medicine and Surgical Disposables.’

Anesthesia charges (as per category) + OT charges (as per category) + Surgery charges (as per category) prescribed above are applicable for semi-private ward. If the beneficiary is entitled for general ward there will be a decrease of 10% in these rates; for private ward entitlement there will be an increase of 15%.

Other conditions as prescribed in Office Memorandum of even number dated 1st October, 2014 remain unchanged.

Commemorative Stamp on Dr. B. R. Ambedkar & Constitution of India - 30th September 2015



Dr Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar (14 April 1891 - 6 December 1956), popularly known as Babasaheb Ambedkar, was one of the architects of the Indian Constitution. He was born to Bhimabai Sakpal and Ramji on 14 April 1891 in Madhya Pradesh.

Babasaheb was a well-known politician, economist, social reformer and an eminent jurist. Ambedkar's efforts to eradicate the social evils like untouchability and caste restrictions were remarkable. The leader, throughout his life, fought for the rights of the dalits and other socially backward classes. Ambedkar was appointed as the nation's first Law Minister in the Cabinet of Jawaharlal Nehru. Bhimrao Ambedkar was appointed as the chairman of the Constitution drafting committee. Ambedkar emphasized on the construction of a virtual bridge between the classes of the society. According to him, it would be difficult to maintain the unity of the Country if the difference among the classes were not met. He was posthumously awarded the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian honor in 1990.

The Union Minister for Communications & Information Technology, Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad released the Commemorative Stamp on Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's 125th Birth Anniversary Year, in New Delhi on 30th September, 2015. The Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment, Shri Thaawar Chand Gehlot and the Minister of State for Social Justice & Empowerment, Shri Vijay Sampla were also present on the occasion.
